

Highway 5: Hope to Merritt

- High Mountain Road: Expect sudden weather changes, have sufficient supplies available
- This is a safe highway, but drivers must drive to conditions and obey speed limits
- Watch for road work and construction
- CVSE and RCMP will be actively patrolling the corridor
- Commercial vehicle operators must complete brake checks and vehicle inspections
- Per legislated requirements, all commercial vehicles over 11,794 kg licensed GVW must carry tire chains and know how to install

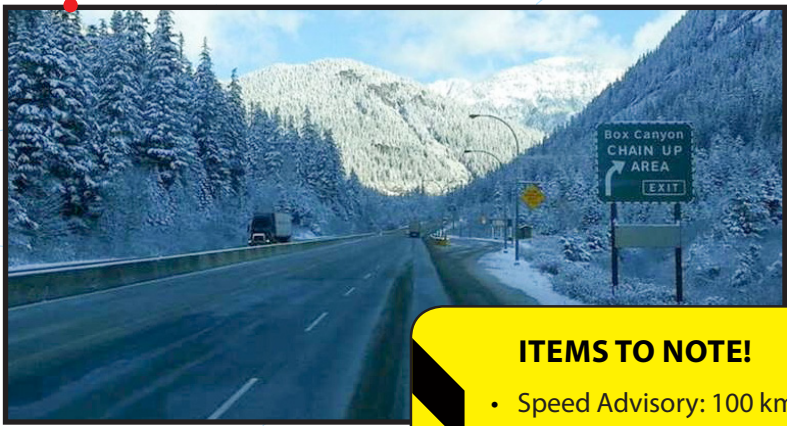

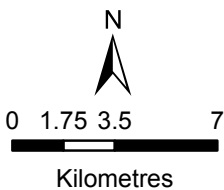

WASHOUT

ITEMS TO NOTE!

- Speed Advisory: 100 km/h in four-lane sections
- Variable cellular service coverage
- Grades of up to 8%
- Commercial vehicles are required to chain-up when chain-up is activated
- No fuel for 110 km between Hope and Merritt
- Electric vehicle (EV) charging stations are not in service
